The offline version of ePEP provides a standalone version of the Plant Energy Profiler tool. You can use this version to run the ePEP tool to create new cases and save the case information to your local computer. This version of the tool runs on Microsoft Windows computers with .NET framework.


- OS Microsoft Windows 7

## Download and Installation instructions


1. Right click on the self-extracting executable file “ePEPOffline.exe”, select option “Run as administrator”




2. Click “OK”




3. The zip file will auto-extract to the C:\ directory, as shown below:




4. Navigate to C:\ePEPOffline, right click on "ConfigWebhost.bat" and select "Run as administrator"




5. If the ConfigWebHost.bat file has been successfully executed, a “Assembly successfully added to the cache” prompt screen will appear, as shown below:




6. Now close the prompt screen, then click “PPC.OfflineRunner.exe”, and then click “start” button



7. Click on the blue link to start ePEP in Internet Explorer (or other default browser on your system.)



8. Click "Create New Case" to start working on a new ePEP case:



## Step 1 - Case Information

Enter a name for your case and select an industry. You may also optionally enter contact information. If you do not see your industry in the drop down list please select Other and enter your industry. Please note that if you select Other, then the energy and cost savings will be calculated using generic nationwide defaults. Click on the More Info link to view definitions for all industries.

If you have a ePEP case file on your computer that you would like to open, follow the instructions below:

1. Click the Browse... button.
2. This will open a dialog box. Use the dialog box to locate the ePEP case file on your computer. It will have an extension of .eep. You will have to remember where you previously saved the ePEP case file.
3. Once you have highlighted the ePEP case file, click the Open button in the dialog box to select the file. You should now see the full name and path of the ePEP case file in the text box.
4. Click the Open Case button. This will upload the case file from your computer to the server, open the case and take you to Step 1 - Case Information.
